

BEHIND THE ART

Who's responsible for the coordination of public art in Johnson City? Well, the public, of course! A dedicated committee of Johnson City residents comprised of artists, teachers, curators, and many other professions work to advance public art-related efforts with support from City staff. Citizens outside the committee are also largely involved in the process, from initiating and conducting projects to actually creating art!

The City Commission appoints 12 members to the Johnson City Public Art Committee (JCPAC), and new memberships become available as existing members rotate off.

Any Johnson City citizen may apply for membership. Members serve 3-year terms on a staggered basis. Keep an eye on our website and blog for announcements about application periods, which typically occur in the fall.

Volunteers are also welcome! JCPAC meetings are open to the public and are held on the [second Wednesday of every month at 5pm in City Hall's Administrative Conference Room.](#)

The JCPAC establishes program policies, sets goals, develops project ideas, oversees the selection of artworks and their locations, secures funding, ensures proper maintenance of the public art collection, and advocates for public art.
